AERC.com, Inc. Diverts Over Fifty Thousand Pounds of Electronic Waste from Landfills at Electronics Recycling Collection Event Held on September 13

Flanders, NJ – September 26, 2008 – Through the combined efforts of AERC.com, Inc (AERC Recycling Solutions), the Borough of Peapack-Gladstone, Peapack-Gladstone Bank and event participants, a total of 50,492 pounds of spent electronics were collected for recycling and kept out of landfills. The Children’s Organ Transplant Association (COTA) is the beneficiary of a donation based on the number of cell phones that were dropped off at the event. Electronics collected have been forwarded for processing to AERC’s NAID Certified Electronics Processing Com-Cycle facility in Allentown, Pennsylvania. All Data contained on any data storage devices has been physically destroyed or wiped according to the Department of Defense Standards.

This event gave community members the opportunity to contribute to AERC’s donation to COTA by recycling old cell phones. As event participants helped the COTA for Kaitlyn Campaign raise funds to support local COTA patient Kaitlyn Cross, they could get a complimentary cup of coffee from Starbucks. For security reasons and the protection phone users, all collected cell phones are being processed by AERC to ensure responsible handling of physical materials as well as following proper data erasure methods.

“As a local community member, I was very pleased to have AERC provide electronics recycling services in Peapack-Gladstone. The incredible turnout at this event demonstrates to me that there is an urgent need for proper disposition of electronics by individuals and small business owners in this area.
